3. Presentations
 - a. Mark Richard- Campus Kiosk Project
 - i. 64 Sun Ray 170 thin clients with 3 servers
 - ii. Kiosks are individually managed by the colleges and LSC
 - iii. Kiosk server is maintained by the College of Engineering
 - iv. Aren't aware of how many students use kiosks
 - v. Every hour or half hour the kiosk will reboot
 - vi. Can support 20 more kiosks with the 3rd server
 - vii. Current failure rate- 1 within the first month of installation
 - viii. LSC- has a problem keeping mice for the kiosks
 - ix. Expansion- 42 more units could be dispersed throughout campus at \$1900 per unit
