- a. Public Access to Kiosks Discussion with Mark Ritschard, Director of ENS
  - i. For the past few years, increasing over the past 6 months, “campers” or transients, not affiliated with the University, have been misusing the kiosks.
  - ii. What can be done to allow access to students and university visitors, but filter out campers.
    1. Guest access for limited time, student still logon for unlimited time
    2. Attach guest group to AMGH with limited access, students would have free access.
  - iii. Continue discussion after legal council is consulted, and vote on final proposal

- a. Google Apps implementation update and discussion - Scott Baily
  - i. Google Apps was chosen over Microsoft as email service provider
  - ii. About a third of the .simla accounts have been transferred to Google Apps by users already. To those who haven't, email notifications have been sent, and they have the opportunity to switch to:

  - iii. Current undergraduate accounts that have not been transferred by spring break will be automatically transferred to First.Last@rams.colostate.edu
  - iv. Undergraduate emails on the current servers will be invalid by 7/1/09
  - v. Login is available at mail.rams.colostate.edu

- vi. Switching to Google Apps allows the ACNS to decommission and redeploy personnel and equipment
- vii. Students will need to update contact information on social networking and similar websites.
