- II. Approval of Minutes from February 7, 2017 Meeting
  - A. Minutes approved by unanimous consent

  - A. CS130/425 Dept Classroom Upgrades Supplemental Proposal – Wayne Trzyna
    1. Room 130 Classroom
      - a) Seats 69 students
      - b) Upgrade eight year old VGA switcher to HDMI
      - c) Add volume control for PA system
    2. CSU CS enrollment growth
      - a) Last 5 years - doubled enrollment
      - b) Non-major enrollment in CS classrooms has also grown
    3. Room 325
      - a) Was a Distance classroom
      - b) Converted to a teaching lab, Spring 2017
      - c) Lab configuration not ideal for distance classes
      - d) Lecture capture equipment is 8 years old
      - e) Seats only 25 students
    4. Room 425
      - a) Currently a conference room
      - b) Propose upgrade to Distance classroom
      - c) Support current CSU lecture capture standards
      - d) HDMI vs VGA
      - e) Ceiling mounted microphones to capture student questions
      - f) Seats 35 students vs 25 in room 325
    5. Budget
      - a) Room 130 upgrades - \$1,775
      - b) Room 425 Lecture Capture Upgrades - \$19,494

- c) Room 425 Ceiling Microphone Array - \$5,993
  - (1) Total projected budget - \$27,262
  - (2) Total UTFAB Request (50%) - \$13,621

*Question:* Can we get more detail in exactly what is being done in each classroom? *Answer:* in 130 we are replacing the switcher, and adding volume control to existing PA system. In 425 what we're doing is installing a complete lecture capture system, podium too.

*Question:* room 325, are you planning on doing renovations to that one or just transferring to that one? *Answer:* there are a bunch of machines in 325, which constricts the space. We are changing 325 into 425, the rooms are fairly similar in terms of the basic room, but the goal is to lay out 425 similar to 325 just without machines in it.

##### A. Budget Review

##### 1. Unallocated funding

- a) Enrollment growth has given UTFAB more funding than projected
- b) Residual balance - \$137,000
  - (1) Does not need to be completely allocated this semester, whatever is leftover will be rolled over to next semester

##### 2. Departmental Proposals

- a) Due by Feb. 27th

*Question:* is there a cap on the amount they can ask for? *Answer:* there is not a cap, it is not in our bylaws to have a cap on supplemental proposals.

*Question:* was the 50% on the CS proposal because it wouldn't be benefitting every student? *Answer:* we ask that if it benefits a certain department/college that they will contribute at least 50%.

*Question:* they can't over allocate, or keep money if there is left over? *Answer:* we do not provide a blank check, any residual comes back to UTFAB. Whatever they propose, they have to spend within the budget. And then we ask that they come back after the project is done and show us the budget/give an update.

  - c) Try to identify which University needs are not being met
2. Meeting 2/13 - update
  - a) UTFAB offering was an upgrade for router switches
    - (1) Needs a refresh
  - b) ATFAB - not technically a fee area yet
    - (1) Few areas of focus where there is problem/need
      - (a) Bike paths, extending bus route hours, extending bus routes, bike sharing, covered bike parking
    - (2) Fee increase - \$21
      - (a) Total = \$41
        - (i) Establish a whole new fee area at \$41
        - (b) Students already pay \$20/semester
          - (i) Transport contract
      - (3) Proposed \$312,000 - to extend a bike path
        - (a) In between rec center and Moby
        - (b) Will be able to integrate with the project on the corner of Elizabeth & Shields - underpass
    - c) Clark & Clark C
      - (1) Gears in motion to renovate the building
      - (2) \$30 million for all three wings

It should be applicable to more than one college for UTFAB to have a need to look at it.
